

After the war, Liverpool was given the more patriotic name of Washington. After Indiana gained statehood, Daviess County was formed in 1817. The boundaries were altered numerous times, eventually reaching their current state in 1828.

Construction of the Wabash and Erie Canal reached Daviess County in 1847, with the towns of Maysville and Plainville becoming important canal depots. Although the canal was short-lived and a logistical and financial disaster, it affected settlement of the county through the influx of Irish laborers who stayed and as a means of transportation for the brief time it was open in the 1850s and 1860s.

It was the coming of the railroad which provided the spark to create much of modern Daviess County as we know it. In 1857, the Ohio and Mississippi Railroad between Cincinnati and St. Louis was completed. Washington grew quickly, becoming the county's first incorporated city in 1871.

The 20th Century saw the slow decay in importance of railroads (last passenger service was in 1971) and small farms nationwide with that impact reflected on the Daviess County population and economy. During World War II, the Crane NWSC naval base was opened in Martin County with considerable effect on the region. Also in the 20th Century, we saw the growth of oil

and gas well production.


The southern part of the county was impacted by the Glendale Fish and Wildlife area, which was started in the 1950s. The Old Order

Amish, a reclusive, traditionalist religious group whose members first arrived in Daviess County in 1868, saw their economic and cultural influence rapidly increase in the latter part of the century through farming, the construction industry, tourism and a rapidly-growing population, now topping about more than 5,000 residents, not including their neighbors all around the county – a large Mennonite group as well.

During the first two decades of the 21st Century, the growth of a diverse manufacturing base and the West Gate Tech Park in the northeastern section of the county has brought jobs and growth. Interstate 69 was completed through Daviess County in late 2015, and has led to more potential growth of business and industry on Washington's east side.



ew area residents have traveled farther than Yasuhiro (Yasu) Ito to make Daviess County their home.

Yasu. 61. relocated to Daviess County in 2017 to serve as president of M & C Tech (Indiana Corporation); his relocation spanned approximately 6,300 miles, and he believes the trip was well worth it

"People made me feel welcome," Yasu said through his interpreter, 23-year-old Mari Kubota. He added that his first few months were difficult due to communication issues, but, by way of computergenerated translation, he and

fellow residents were able to talk until his translator arrived in Washington.

His arrival was not without some trepidation as he was used to living and working in much-larger cities; he was concerned about being able to attract and retain quality and qualified employees in a community the size of Daviess County (approximate population of 33,000).

"As it turns out, Daviess County is a great place," Yasu said, adding, "everything is great and my (35) employees do a great job; we are like family here."

His company manufactures automotive extrusion products,

which can be categorized generically as parts for sunroofs.

In 2010, Yasu led a similar foreign start-up venture in China, and was the company's choice to start the production line in Daviess County. Yasu, the father of two children and grandfather of two (with another grandchild on the way), has been with the company for more than 40 years as he started with the company immediately after he earned his college degree in chemical engineering while in Japan. He never thought he would leave Japan.

"This has been a very good move," Yasu said, "even though I miss Japanese food."

ob and Jo Arthur have made Washington their home for 43 years and never once considered leaving.

"This is home," Bob, a retired judge, commented, adding, "We never have given relocation any serious thought."

And, that is quite an accomplishment as his wife, who grew up in Sullivan County, wasn't certain Daviess County was where she wanted to settle.

Jo was busy with her Georgia Tech University under-graduate work, which brought her to Washington in 1976. She

felt welcomed when she arrived, met Bob in the process, and the two have made Washington their home ever since.

"My graduate work may have brought me here, but friendship and community keep me here," Jo noted.

The couple is free to move since all three grown children have been out of the house, but the pair has no intentions of leaving.

"Everything we need is here," Jo said.

Bob pointed out that Daviess County is the ideal spot because it is close enough to metropolitan areas that it is an easy drive if one wants to go there.

While friends in Florida have encouraged the Arthurs to sell their Daviess County residence and move south, the Arthurs are not interested.

"It is nice to visit Florida, especially in the winter, but we're too happy in Washington to move," Jo remarked.


medical school," Dr. Porter noted. "And I wanted to move back to Daviess County to give her the opportunity to put her degree to use."



LOOKING TO RELOCATE?

Daviess County just may be the best choice you could make.



More than 32,000 people already know

what an independent research group recently published: Daviess County provides quite the Bang for the Buck.

SmartAsset, a web-based financial planning site. released results of its fifth annual study relative to Indiana property taxes, and Daviess County

ranked second in the state in what SmartAsset terms Overall Value Index. Daviess County's Overall Value Index was a mere .57 behind Jay County as **Daviess** County's index was

98 compared to Jay County's index of 98.57.

The index is the result of researching metrics such as: Quality of schools,


local crime rates and property taxes, in an attempt by SmartAsset to pinpoint where people and businesses realize the most value for their tax dollars. The following chart shows the rankings published by Smart Asset in February 2019.

It should be noted that "Crimes per 100,000 people" is estimated for counties that do not have 100,000 residents. Daviess County's population (at the time of the study) was 32,777. Data used to support the findings is contained in U.S. Census Bureau 2017 American Community Survey, Department of Education, Federal Bureau of Investigation, and State Police or Justice Department websites.

The study is not commissioned by any agency or municipality; rather, it is SmartAsset's attempt to identify where industry, retail and residents might consider locating.

Not included in the study is the unemployment rate, which would have improved Daviess County's position. Hoosierdata.in.gov posted 2018 non-seasonally adjusted unemployment rate, and not only did Daviess County beat the state average, it posted the lowest unemployment rate in a four-county area. To the right is a chart that compares counties Daviess, Knox, Martin and Pike to the state unemployment rate.







hile some communities might have all their employment eggs invested in a single company or industry in Daviess County the basket is full of companies that range from value added agricultural operations, to historical heavy industry, to companies involved in the modern defense industry.

AGRICULTURE

Agriculture is a major player in the local economy and also in terms of jobs. Perdue Farms provides an estimated 1,000 jobs in the area. The company is vertically designed in southwestern Indiana and in Daviess County includes a large feed mill, grow-out contract farms, plus hundreds of jobs in the turkey processing plant.

Another value-added business making a difference in the Daviess County economy is Grain Processing Corporation. The company operates a major wetmill corn processing operation. It produces everything from corn from alcohol to animal feed. The company employs almost 200 people in Daviess County and is in the process of a major expansion of its MALTRIN operations.

Both GPC and Perdue are major purchasers of corn in southwestern Indiana. Both utilize hundreds of thousands of bushels each year impacting the trucking industry as well as farms.

IMPACT OF THE RAILROAD

When Washington was just beginning to develop over 100 years ago one of the biggest impacts on the town came when the railroad shops opened on the city's west side. Those shops have gone through a lot of changes over the years, but they are still a major part of the local job picture. Two years ago Eagle Railcar

purchased the shops and began to use them to refurbish rail cars. The Washington operation is the first for Eagle in Indiana and in quick fashion the company has gone from zero to 150 workers with even more additions on the horizon.

MINING

Another traditional industry in Daviess County is coal mining. At times the county has had as many as one dozen mines in operation. These days there is one mine in full operation and another that is in the midst of getting started. Both are owned by White Stallion Coal of Evansville and have around 80

The mines are not the only employers because of coal in Daviess County. Trucking, machinery and support businesses also provide jobs. McAllister Machinery has more than 50 employees providing equipment and support to the coal mines still operating in southern Indiana.

NEWER COMPANIES

Some of the newer companies in Daviess County are also making a big impact. M&C Tech became the first Japanese owner company to open along I-69. The firm makes plastic parts for the auto industry. It is on the way toward hiring as many as 100 people as it expands its shifts.

Another growing neighbor to M&C is Isoflex Packaging. The plastics company has three lines making plastic packaging for industry.

Another plastics operator is Berry



Plastics just outside of Odon. The subsidiary of Evansville-based Berry Plastics has gone through several expansions and makes plastic film for business and industry.



AMISH COMMUNITY

Those modern operations are found alongside several successful businesses in the Daviess County Amish community. K&K Industries, Daviess County Metal, and Graber Post Buildings employ hundreds of people. The companies build trusses and put up buildings all over the eastern half of the United States. Amish work crews totaling more than 100 are working throughout the Midwest with these companies.

The entire area along CR 900E is a growth area for Amish-based business. The county has been participating in a muti-million dollar expansion to allow the trucks that supply the businesses to safely operate with the more than 100

businesses along the roadway that include cabinet shops, sawmills, an auction house, produce center and two large community buildings.

CLOTHING

Daviess County has its own corner of the clothing business. NASCO Industries has around 100 workers turning out outerwear for the oil, utility and energy industries. The employee-owned firm has had so much success it is expanding.

Another clothing company, and again one that has more to do with utility than fashion, is Tri-Star Glove. The Plainville-based business has been in operation since 2001, employs around 50 people and makes gloves for the auto industry.

A DIVERSE MIX

Cornelius Manufacturing, between Elnora and Odon, sits right on I-69. The company makes its uniquely designed Corn-pro trailers there that have become very popular with people moving small numbers of livestock.

Belt Tech Industrial, south of Washington, 1996 S 300 W, serves the coal and power producing companies in the area. Establishing a reputation for quality work, business grew quickly that first year leading to the need for a larger facility to handle an increasing inventory of belting, pulleys, bearings, shafting, etc. Headquartered in Washington, its territory has expanded into multiple states and now has a focus on the national market.

One thing southern Indiana is known for is the furniture industry and Daviess County has its own little piece of that. Olon Industries has its North American Headquarters in Washington. The company specializes in building drawers for wood furniture.

Northern Daviess County is a mix of Amish-based business and some high-tech operation. Alion Science and Technology built a major operation in the WestGate Technology Park where it repairs equipment for the aviation industry, Applied Logistic Services in Odon provides professional services to Crane, while family-owned Stoll Brothers Lumber has seen growth because of the WestGate @ Crane Tech Park development and its strong work ethic and attention to the details.

ood neighbors are not hard to find in Daviess County and those in the job market or who are looking for business opportunities may not find a better neighbor than Naval Surface Warfare Center, Crane Division, which is located just across the Daviess County border in Martin County.

NSWC is a high-tech agency that provides support to the U.S. military, primarily the Navy, but also provides technical support for the Naval Air Command, Marine Corps, Special Operations and Air Force. Employees at NSWC ensure our troops are able to operate and maintain equipment designed to help the warfighter complete its mission and return home safely. NSWC Crane is responsible for equipment on virtually every

USN ship and submarine and even provides support for foreign military sales for ally countries such as Australia and Saudi Arabia.

Supporting the warfighter is the number one priority for NSWC's employees, of which about 10 percent are Daviess County residents. NSWC employs about 3,400 people; of whom 73 percent are scientists, engineers and technicians, and 296 are Daviess County residents. They do annual business totaling more than \$1.4 billion. Crane Army Ammunition Activity employs another 800 staffers

With more than 1 million square feet of offices and laboratories, Crane provides a distinct advantage in sensors, communications, mobility, special munitions and weapons.

Main priorities in the Crane product mix include cybersecurity, hypersonics, trusted electronics, threat modeling, predictive analytics, human systems engineering, artificial intelligence, modeling and simulation.

Daviess County residents employed at NSWC earn approximately \$26.1 million annually. Further, Daviess County businesses account for \$8.2 million in contracts with NSWC.

Businesses interested in doing business with NSWC can participate in the Buy Indiana Days, an event conducted annually at French Lick Resort.

A new multi-county and state agency group, White River Military Coordination Alliance, was formed in 2019 to "aggressively support," long-term economic development and the creation of military value for the nearly 100-square-mile NSA Navy facility, the third largest Navy base in the world.

The base also engages area students, from elementary to college age in promoting career and learning opportunities in STEM, helping more than 6,000 students, and more than 100 teachers in 30 schools in 2018.

WESTGATE TECH PARK

Defense contractors at the WestGate Tech Park support the





Naval Surface Warfare Center Crane Division by providing personnel and physical space needed by the Department of Navy. While the number of employees varies by contract, NSWC Crane Division relies heavily on the contractor support.

Ever-changing U.S. Navy needs are met by about 25 different vendors that include: AECOM, Alion, Artisan Electronics, Battery Innovation Center, BrightVolt, CACI, CJSeto, D2D, DTA, FLIR, General Dynamics, GeoNorth, IODD, Indiana University, JRC, McKeane, Precise Systems, Raydar, SAIC, STIMULUS Engineering, Tri-Star Engineering, University of Louisville; University of Southern Indiana, WestGate Authority, and, WILLCOR.

Nearby West Gate Academy, a conference and training center at 13598 E. WestGate Drive, focuses on workforce education, government and military contract support, technical transfer and incubation, and conferencing. Its largest room encompasses more than 14,000 square feet of space.

WestGate has partnerships with Purdue and Indiana universities, and offers state-of-the-art facilities with built-in audio-video services, 18 private classrooms, two computer labs, professional catering and on-site parking.

or someone who wants a piece of land to build, there is room for growth in many of the subdivisions and other land available for development.



Washington has most of the county's population at 36.9 percent, while offering amenities like trash pickup and various Internet options, there are high-end neighborhoods like Green Acres, Alexander Estates, White Ridge Court, Deer Creek, Bean Drive and Piankeshaw Trail.

Less expensive, mid-range homes can be found north of Eastside Park on Park Avenue, Lakeview Drive, Glenwood Drive and Sugarland Road with average three-bedrooms selling for about \$141,000, plus.

Washington has middle- to lowincome housing options available in Cherry Tree Apartments on the east side and Westwood Crossing Apartments on the city's west side and various duplexes, and through the Washington Housing Authority with rental options. THINGS TO

If you're visiting or planning to call us home, there are plenty of things to see and do in Daviess County. There are parks and lakes for picnicking, boating, fishing and hunting, golf (pro-courses and mini-golf), as well as a large Amish settlement, and a jackpot drawing that attracts thousands.

WASHINGTON COUNTRY CLUB

The Washington Country Club, 908 Bedford Road, is a nine-hole course that offers elevation changes.

Playing between 4,920 and 5,366 yards, the course features two of the more difficult par threes in the area. The course, with many narrow fairways, is challenging but fun for amateurs and pros alike.

Yearly memberships are available, but the course is open to the public. The Country Club is also available for outings.

Leagues are held for men and women.

Inside the club, Aces Restaurant is open daily for dining. Soft drinks and beer are available. Additional adult beverages are served at Aces Restaurant, where you will find live entertainment almost every Saturday night.



COUNTRY OAKS

Country Oaks, located on U.S. 50 one mile west of Montgomery, offers five teeing areas that stretch the 18-hole course from 4,983 to 6,966 yards.

A driving range is offered and used for lessons from Trey Miller, general manager.

A well-stocked pro shop offers equipment and soft goods. The property's old home is used for private parties and gatherings.

Sandwiches and hot dogs are available, as well as a variety of snacks and soft drinks.

Season passes may be purchased. The course is open to the public and is available for outings.

Leagues are held for men and women and many high school matches are played there..

WEST BOGGS

West Boggs Park spreads across 1,500 acres in Daviess and Martin counties. The lake itself is 622 acres, with the main entrance located on SR 231 north of Loogootee.

Boating, fishing and camping are main attractions at the park.

The park offers a laid-back type of atmosphere and encourages the usage of personal golf carts to make the facility more accessible to all ages.

Park programming offers different events each weekend, featuring activities in forestry, water or boating. Boats of all sizes are generally welcome, with a 35 mile-perhour limit set. Skiing and jet skiing are also a feature on the lake.

Stoll's Lakeview Restaurant and Lakeview Golf Course are also park attractions. Both entities are operated privately.

Water fowl hunting is encouraged during season. The park also has areas available

for general hunting during appropriate seasons.

Campsites are available for year-round camping. The park is closed to noncampers from 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. Park facility usage is possible during the hours with permission of park officials.

PUTTER'S BAY MINI GOLF

Putter's Bay is an 18-hole layout playing to a par 42. Located at 1 Putter's Bay, it offers play from early spring through late fall depending upon weather.

Individual game prices vary by age, with persons ages 3 and under free.

The facility welcomes groups, parties and fundraisers along with the public, and was designed without steps or stairs for the handicapped. Putter's Bay offers three four-week leagues starting in June and ending in August. Participants play Monday through Thursday, with scores posted weekly. The course also serves as host for the Midwest Mini-Golf Championship held annually in October.

In season, the facility opens weekdays from 5 until 10 p.m. school days. When school is not in session, hours are noon until 11 p.m. Putter's opens weekends noon until 10 p.m.

KINGPIN BOWLING CENTER

Kingpin Bowling Center is a 24-lane family recreation center located at 2100 E. State St, Washington..

Fishing is also available at the two lakes within the park. Boats are allowed, and may have trolling motors.


Several miles of paved surfaces are used for walking or running. Basketball courts and a large playground area are also offered.


